### FREE COUNSELING

A private adoption counselor from Full Circle can meet with you to provide neutral information about all your options: Adoption, Kinship, Termination, & Parenting

### CHOOSING A FAMILY

If you choose adoption, you can choose the family that feels, to you, like the right choice for your child.

### LIVING EXPENSES

Adoption agencies can help with pregnancy related living expenses. A private case-worker will help you determine eligibility for financial assistance during the pregnancy.

### BENEFIT SERVICES

We can help you access the benefits for which you may be eligible such as Medicaid, transitional assistance, food stamps, WIC, and others. Full Circle can assist expectant parents in document recovery (State ID, driver's licenses, social security cards and birth certificates) which may be needed for benefits.

After you've had the opportunity to consider all of your options with your private caseworker, and, if you wish to take the next steps in adoption, we take the time to learn more about your needs and what you're looking for in an adoptive family. The agency caseworker then can share family profiles with you. Together with your caseworker, you can have phone, video or in-person conversations with potential families before making your choice. Depending upon your state's law, you may choose to submit to the jurisdiction of Massachusetts and have a legally enforceable communication agreement for visits and photo/letter updates in the years ahead. If you live in Maine, you can choose to submit to the jurisdiction of Massachusetts and have a legally enforceable communication agreement for visits and photo/letter updates in the years ahead.

All adoptive families are thoroughly screened and evaluated in a process that is called a "home study." This is an evaluation of the families which includes, but is not limited to: their relationship, their larger family, community circumstances, a home inspection, legal background checks and their health. A clinical social worker spends many hours getting to know the prospective adoptive parents before they are approved to move forward with adoption.
